Dear Parents/Guardians of Juniors and Seniors at Natick High School,

The Natick High School After Prom Party Committee has been working hard over the past six months to provide our students with the 31st annual event to be held the night of the Prom at NHS starting at midnight.

GUIDELINES:

We know that you, as parents, will understand the need for the following guidelines:

- If we have reason to believe a student has been using alcohol and/or other drugs, we will contact the student's parents to please come and pick your child up. The student(s) will remain with an adult on duty until the parent(s) arrive. Students will face school consequences outlined in the Student Handbook.
- Once a student has entered the building if he or she wants to leave before 5:00 am, you will be informed by APP staff at that time by phone unless your child has pre-approved permission to be dismissed (see below). If there is no answer, we will leave a message letting you know your child is leaving the party.
- <u>NEW THIS YEAR:</u> Click on this <u>link</u> to fill out the form giving the APP staff permission to check out your child without a phone call the night of the party. An APP committee member will call to confirm before Prom Night. This form must be completed no later than <u>Thursday, May 9th</u>.

These guidelines are to protect everyone involved

REGISTRATION:

- ALL NHS JUNIORS and SENIORS are automatically signed up on our list to attend this event even if they do not attend prom.
- ALL OTHER PROM GUESTS who attend the prom are automatically registered for this event
- No guest over the age of 20 will be allowed to attend this event
- Registration check-in is open Midnight 1am. Check out will not be allowed before 1:15am.

This party is 100% FREE for all who attend! We have a spectacular night planned! Come race a friend on our obstacle courses. Try the bungee trampolines. Play laser tag or video arcade games with friends. Strike a funny pose in the photo booth. NATICK HIGH SCHOOL AFTER PROM PARTY RULES

- 1. Doors to NHS will open at 11:45 pm. Doors will close at 1:00 am. No one will be admitted after this time. No one will be dismissed before 1:15 pm.
- 2. You **DO NOT** need to **attend the PROM** to come to the party if you are a Natick High School Junior or Senior. You are registered to attend the APP.
- **3.** All guests who are registered and attend the Prom are registered for the APP.
- 4. All students and guests should change into comfortable clothes **BEFORE** arriving to the party. **We have no place for students to put their dresses or tuxedos.**
- **5.** All students and guests must sign in upon entry to the party.
- **6. NO outside containers are allowed at the party.** We will have plenty of food and beverages available throughout the night.
- 7. All students and guests must check out if leaving before 5:00 am. For those students who do not have pre-approved permission to be dismissed, an APP chaperone will call home informing the parent of your student's checkout. Once a student or guest leaves, they are NOT permitted back into the building.
- **8.** NO smoking or vaping in the school building or on school property is permitted.
- **9.** Students deemed to be disruptive will be asked to leave. Parents will be notified.
- **10.** Students or guests found to be in possession of or under the influence of alcohol or other drugs will face all school consequences outlined in the Student Handbook.
- **11.** Students and guests are to leave the building by the FRONT DOOR only.
- **12. Bags are NOT permitted inside the APP.** A location for bags will be available outside the entrance of the party. We are not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- **13.** ALL food and beverages (other than water) must stay in the cafeteria.
- **14.** As a reminder: between the hours of 12:30 am and 5:00 am, it is illegal for anyone under the age of 18 to operate a motor vehicle.
